DELEGATION POLICY

Delegation Composition

1. The minimum number of delegates required to qualify for a delegation is 7 members.
2. There is no limit to the number of delegates who can be a part of the delegation.

Delegate Registration

1. A delegation must register in order to qualify for the Best Delegation Award. Delegations are required to send an email at karma.modelun@gmail.com with the following details of all delegates in an excel sheet: a. Name b. Contact Number c. Email Address d. School/College e. Committee preference f. Allotment preference

2. The subject line of the email should be as follows, "Delegation Registration: Name of Delegation"
 3. A Delegation can choose to be an Institutional or Non-Institutional Delegation. The same must be specified in the email. If a Delegation is registering as an Institutional Delegation, they must all belong to the same College or School.
 4. If an institutional delegation consists of a delegate who has not admitted to the institution then that delegation will be disqualified from contention for the best delegation award.
 5. The email must be sent by the head delegate to the Secretariat on or before 25th August 2021.
 6. Any registration emails post the given deadline shall not be entertained except at the discretion of the Secretariat.

Mode of communication

1. The Head Delegate will serve as the sole point of contact.
2. Any communication or instructions given by the Secretariat to the Head Delegate will be deemed to have been given or made to the entire delegation.



3. If any delegation from your institution is already participating in Karma MUN then you cannot be a part of any other non-institutional delegation.

Point allocation for awards

1. The points allocated for awards in all committees are: a. Best Delegate/Portfolio: 50 Points b. High Commendation: 30 Points c. Special Mention: 10 Points
2. In the case of multiple awards in the same category, the points will be divided between the winners of that category.



In case of a tie

1. In case two delegations have the same number of points, the Delegation which wins a higher number of Best Delegates will win and in case they are also the same it will be followed by High Commendations and subsequently by Special Mentions in case of a tie of a number of High Commendations.
2. In case all of the above is the same, the Delegation which has more members will win.

In case of any situation or issues which may arise that are not stipulated in the Policy, the decision made by the Secretariat shall be final and binding.
